

Monday	<p>Phonics: Buried treasure, segment and blend to sort the real and the fake words and put them into the treasure chest and the bin.</p> <p>Writing: Watch the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Draw pictures of the story and sequence them to the correct order.</p>	Help Jack order the magic beans.	 <p>This week, we are learning about the traditional tale of Goldilocks and the 3 Bears. Goldilocks goes through the woods and finds a cottage with nice warm porridge, chairs and beds but doesn't like all of them. Segment and blend the words to read and match them to the correct picture.</p> <p>Writing: Draw a story map of the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and retell the story to an adult.</p>	Cut out numbers and glue on the number line. Order the numbers to 20.	
Wednesday	<p>Phonics: Read the sentence in the box and then draw a picture of what the sentence describes.</p> <p>Writing: Write a sentence about a part of the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' of your choice. Have a go at spelling your tricky words correctly.</p>	Look at the number tracks. Fill in the missing numbers.	
Thursday	<p>Phonics: Have a go at spelling some of the tricky words we have learnt this week.</p> <p>Writing: It's now time to write the story of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Practicing retelling the story first and then have a go at writing the story.</p>	Cut out the fish and order them 0 - 20
